DID YOU KNOW?

Hot cars can mean serious danger for kids. It is rarely done intentionally, but in a matter of minutes, children left in hot cars can suffer greatly. Car temperatures rise quickly, leaving children susceptible to heat stroke, seizures, and even death. Temperature in a car can rise 30 to 40 degrees in just a half an hour. Consider installing a safety mirror in the back of your car to help keep an eye on children, and never leave them alone in the car, even for a few minutes. Los automóviles calientes pueden significar un grave peligro para los niños. Muy rara vez se hace intencionalmente, pero en cuestión de minutos los niños que quedan en los autos calientes pueden sufrir mucho. La temperatura de los automóviles sube rápidamente, dejando a los niños susceptibles a ataques de calor, convulsiones e incluso la muerte. La temperatura en un coche puede subir 30 a 40 grados en apenas media hora. Considere la posibilidad de instalar un espejo de seguridad en la parte posterior de su auto para ayudar a mantener un ojo en los niños, y nunca los deje solos en el carro, ni siquiera por unos minutos. 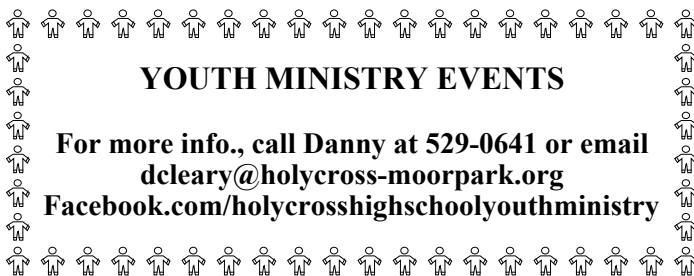

TRADICIONES DE NUESTRA FE

Los cristianos creemos que Jesucristo está físicamente presente en el pan y el vino consagrado durante la Misa. Esta creencia es tan antigua como nuestra Iglesia, pero fue solo en el siglo XIII que los cristianos comenzaron a venerar la presencia sacramentada de Jesús en la hostia. Fue durante esta época que nació la fiesta de Corpus Cristi o la actual celebración del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Muchas comunidades cristianas celebran esta fiesta con procesiones y cantos en honor al Santísimo Sacramento del altar.

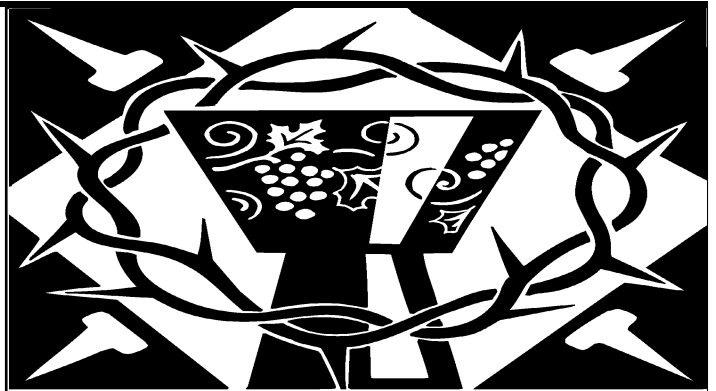
Recuerdo que en Texas el pueblo mexicanoamericano cantaba: “Bendito, bendito, bendito sea Dios, / los ángeles cantan y alaban a Dios (2x). Yo creo Dios mío que estas en el altar / oculto en la hostia ten vengo adorar (2x)”. Este canto enfatiza la verdadera presencia de Jesús en el pan consagrado, pero sus cantores ignoran el hecho que nosotros también fuimos consagrados en el Bautismo; consagrados para “alter Christus” (otro Cristo) en el vecindario. En un mundo donde menos gente asiste a Misa el único Corpus Cristi que la mayoría de la gente secularizada verá es tu cuerpo. Ojalá podamos comportarnos como buenos testigos de la fe y que proclamemos “bendito, bendito” siempre y en todo lugar.
